

A Brush With Burchfield
Supply List

¾" flat watercolor brush, plus a number 4 and a number 12 round brush, or equivalents.
2 pieces of artist grade cold pressed or rough 140# watercolor paper, 9" x 12" (Arches, Fabriano, Fluid 100).

Tubes or pans of colors: Ultramarine blue or cobalt blue; Burnt umber or burnt sienna; Raw umber or yellow ochre; sap green.

A palette for your paint for the 4 colors, with a white mixing area; a white plastic food plate will do.

A soft pencil (2B) and a gum eraser (General or Art Gum brand).

A waterproof board, at least 10" x 13", to support your paper. Two clips to clamp your paper to your board and/or a roll of 1" Scotch brand (tan) masking tape.

A rag or paper towels, or facial tissues for mopping up. Scraps of watercolor paper to try out your color mixes.

A plastic water jar with a wide mouth (an old food container will do). A sketchbook and pen for note taking.

If you cannot get all the supplies you need before the time of this event, or you forget something at home, come to the event anyway. We will have extra supplies for you to use.
