

Stone Setting: Flush Setting

Here's a list of optional items to bring with you. If you don't have these items, don't worry. I'll have some available to share.

- Magnification (Optivisor, reading glasses, or loupe)
- Sharpie
- Dividers
- Small straight-edge (metal ruler)
- Calipers (preferably digital)
- Scribe
- Center punch
- Bezel pusher/burnisher
- An old bur that you no longer need (to be re-purposed into a fine-point burnisher)

Please bring \$15 (cash or check) with you to reimburse me for the supply kit you will use in class, which includes:

- (10) 3mm round faceted CZ stones
- (6) copper squares
- (1) each of the following: 3mm round bur, 2mm hart bur, and 1.0, 1.5 and 2.0mm drill bits

I'll demonstrate the technique and have a handout available, but you may also want to take a few notes. We'll start with a single stone to get the feel of it, then progress to multiples in straight lines and curves, all in a flat surface. Although we won't practice setting the stones into a curve (such as a ring), the technique is the same and I'll provide some additional tips.
