

Mixed Media Mayhem: 20 Paintings in 2 Days!

Supply List:

Acrylic paints: Black, White, Blue, Yellow, Red, Brown (**best if no smaller than 8 oz. jars or tubes**) and any additional colors you already have

Acrylic Gel Medium (you can choose from matte, gloss, semi-gloss, soft, regular or hard...any type will work **as long as it is called "acrylic GEL medium"**)

Paint brushes – 3 or 4 in a variety of sizes and a 2" or 3" wide foam paintbrush

Plastic container for water (needs to be something big enough for your wide brushes to fit in)

A piece of medium grain sand paper

Any type of paint palette (can use something like a paper plate)

5 or 6 sheets of 18x24" paper (**something sturdier than drawing paper and multi media tablets...watercolor paper works well**)

Scrap paper or a sketchbook

Roll of paper towels

Optional: scissors, letter and number stencils, painter's tape, charcoal, pencil, sponge, a few photos or magazine images of people, places, food, objects or text you like, receipts, medicine dropper, India ink, candle, Sharpie, bubble wrap, coloring book pages, old toothbrush, rubber stamps, roller brushes, Qtips, Brillo pad, recycled styrofoam, words, poems, quotes on printer paper, graph paper, old music sheets
