

## **Watercolor Portraits with Emily Moll Wood**

### **Supply List**

12x16 (ish) Watercolor paper - Hot or Cold Press is fine, whatever you prefer.  
Demos will be done on both.

Watercolor Brushes - A variety of Rounds and Filberts, just make sure you have at least 1 small Round for detail work.

Watercolor Paints- I am not very particular about colors yet, as I am still deciding what I like best! These are the colors I have been using and will be demoing with: French Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue, Quinacridone Magenta, Cadmium Red, Quinacridone Gold, Cadmium Yellow, Van Dyke Brown, Burnt Sienna.

Watercolor Pencils - These are what I start watercolor portraits with, so make sure you have at least one or 2 different skin tone colors like Burnt Sienna, Red Oxide, Cadmium orange, Burnt Orange, Venetian Red, or Yellow Ochre.

Soft absorbent paper towels

I will provide photos that I will demonstrate from for the first class, but you are welcome to bring your own photo to work from. Just make sure it is a good quality photo that is zoomed in enough with good enough lighting to see all of the details.
