

# Supply List for *From Photo to Drawing*

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## Day 1, Photography Part

- Smartphone
- Digital Camera (DSLR or Advanced Point and Shoot) – optional (you can use just a smart phone)
- Notebook for note taking
- A personal object or objects that you would like to photograph

## Day 2, Drawing Part

- Basic set of graphite pencils
- Vine or compressed charcoal
- Kneaded eraser
- White vinyl eraser
- Cloth for smudging and wiping
- Set of pastels (optional)
- Clips or tape to hold paper to a drawing board
- Sketchbook sized paper, 8x10 to 9x12 in size (you can bring an entire sketchbook, or just sheets, but make sure it is a drawing paper of at least 60 lbs, with 90 to 100 lbs being preferable)

*Please note:* Due to the nature of this workshop, you will need to be able to print the photos you take on your camera or phone. This will be discussed day 1 of class, and we will help make sure you can do this. You will need printed photos to work from for day 2, thus the requirement. Alternatively, if you have a tablet device like an Android tablet or an iPad, and can get your photos from your camera or phone to the tablet, you can use that to draw from on day 2.
